The Ikenobo Ikebana Society of Boston is a local chapter of the Ikenobo Ikebana Society of America and is officially recognized by Headquarters of the Ikenobo School of Floral Art, Kyoto Japan. The Ikenobo school began over 550 years ago in Japan and is the origin of Ikebana. Our arrangements range from traditional to modern free style.

The Boston Chapter presents eight or nine workshops yearly, usually on a Tuesday or Saturday. The October Workshop is taught by a Professor visiting from Japan; the remainder are taught by certified local teachers or high-ranking teachers from other Chapters. Cost per Workshop ranges from \$55-\$80 (very occasionally higher) and includes floral material. Currently, in-person meetings are held at St. Agnes Church, 186 Woburn St., Reading MA

Annual membership dues (due in December) are:

Regular membership \$55

Special membership (optional; for Level 6 and above) \$125

Local membership (one-time only for those who join after March 15) \$25

Associate membership (those whose primary membership is with another Chapter) \$30
